ABOUT THE CLUB

The Memorial Bend Club, Inc. (MBC) is a registered non-profit, member-only club founded in 1958, located in the Memorial Bend Subdivision. Our membership is open to residents of the subdivision as well as individuals and families from the surrounding community.

Current amenities include a pool, playground, and swim team (a separately organized entity). A new pavilion, restrooms, and courts are currently in the permitting phase, more exciting improvements are on the way.

The Club is governed by its bylaws and applicable state and federal regulations and is operated entirely by a volunteer board of directors and its members.

MEMBERSHIP

Types of Membership

All memberships are household memberships, covering individuals residing at (or staying extended periods at) the address on file. Each household may hold only one membership.

Regular Members pay an initial enrollment fee plus lower annual dues. Regular Members hold a position responsibility in the club and are eligible to serve on the Board and vote in elections or other matters requiring a member vote.

Limited Members pay higher annual dues and enjoy full use of all amenities. Limited Members may not serve on the Board or vote.

Guests & Caretakers

Regular caretakers – such as grandparents, nannies, and babysitters – may use Club facilities only when accompanying the members in their care.

Members may invite guests to use the pool or racquet facilities. A \$5.00 per-guest fee applies, payable via Zelle to memorialbendclub@gmail.com. Members are responsible for their guests at all times. Guests may not be on Club grounds without an adult member present; this includes teen guests.

VOLUNTEERING

The Club depends on members to volunteer for a variety of small jobs and workdays. Each household is encouraged to participate in at least two volunteer opportunities per season.

Opportunities include:

- Serving on the Board of Directors
- Trash duty and grounds clean-up
- Social event support
- Administrative tasks

If you notice something that needs attention – a full trash can, litter, or a minor repair – please take care of it. Replacing a trash liner or bringing bins in from the curb is always appreciated.

GENERAL GROUNDS RULES

- Hours of operation: dawn to dusk, year-round.
- Pets are not permitted on the grounds.
- Smoking is prohibited on all Club grounds, including the pool and court areas.
- Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated.
- Please clean up after yourself and your guests. Leave the Club in better condition than you found it.
- If a trash can is full, transfer the bag to one of the city containers near the main gate.

POOL

Operations

The pool is operated on a swim-at-your-own-risk basis. There is no lifeguard on duty during regular hours. Swimmers assume full responsibility for their own safety.

The pool is maintained year-round. Chemical treatment and cleaning occur twice per week; the pool will be closed on those days. Specific closure days will be communicated via email at the start of each season.

If you require lighting for an event, please coordinate with a Board member in advance.

Pool Rules

- Children 14 and under must be accompanied by a member who is 16 or older.
- Parents are responsible for monitoring their children's safety and rule compliance. Children who are weak swimmers must have an adult in the water with them.
- No diving from the diving board unless a lifeguard is present. This is a city ordinance.
- Pool access is restricted to members only per city code.
- Do not prop the main gate open. If you are the last to leave, lock the pool access gate.
- Appropriate attire is required. Please be mindful of logos and messaging in a family-friendly environment.
- No glass in the pool area. Plastic and aluminum containers only.
- No running or rough play on the pool deck.
- Members are responsible for the behavior and safety of their guests at all times.
- Please help maintain the pool area: if a trash can is full, empty it and replace the liner.

Swim Team

The Memorial Bend Swim Team (MBST Barracudas) holds practices and meets in May and June. Meets are typically held the first three Mondays of June; practices run Monday mornings in June and Monday afternoons in May.

RENTALS AND PRIVATE PARTIES

The Club may be rented for private events. A group of 10 or more is considered a party and is subject to the rental policy.

- Lifeguards are required for all parties. The host is responsible for arranging and paying the lifeguard vendor directly.
- Pool parties may be scheduled during normal operating hours or after hours. The pool will not be closed to other members during normal operating hours for exclusive party use.
- Please confirm availability with the Club before contacting the lifeguard vendor.
- Standard parties require at least two weeks' advance notice to the lifeguard vendor. Holiday parties require at least three weeks.

ONE FINAL REMINDER: DO NOT SHARE THE GATE CODE WITH ANYONE WHO IS NOT A MEMBER.

A NOTE ON MEMBERSHIP

The Club is what its members make it. Most of our members live in Memorial Bend, but membership is entirely voluntary. We encourage you to invite your neighbors to join, even if they belong to another club or have a private pool. At less than \$40 per month, MBC membership is an affordable way to support your only neighborhood gathering space, preserve local greenspace, and stay connected to the community.
